

**COMPENSATION RATES**

**TEMPORARY TOTAL DISABILITY (TTD)**

**MAXIMUM TTD:**

66.66% of the employee's average weekly wage (AWW) during the year (52 weeks) preceding the accident date but not to exceed the statutory maximum TTD in effect on the date injury (See: Maximum Weekly Rate Tables).

**MINIMUM TTD:** As follows or the employee's AWW, whichever is less:

**DISFIGUREMENT and PERMANENT PARTIAL DISABILITY (PPD) (without amputation or eye enucleation)**

**MAXIMUM PPD & DISFIGUREMENT:**

Pre 7-1-1984: 66.66% of the employee's AWW subject to maximums set out in the Maximum Weekly Rate Tables.

Post 7-1-1984: 60% of the employee's AWW subject to maximums set out in the Maximum Weekly Rate Tables.

The rate cannot exceed the statutory maximum in effect on the date of injury.

**MINIMUM PPD & DISFIGUREMENT:** As follows or the employee's AWW, whichever is less:

PERMANENT PARTIAL DISABILITY (PPD) (with amputation or eye enucleation)

MAXIMUM PPD: Statewide Average Weekly Wage (SAWW) multiplied by 133.3333%  
Except for Jan. 15, 2010 to July 14, 2010 Maximum PPD stays at \$1,243 (based on prior SAWW since Jan.-July 2010 SAWW decreased).  
Also July 15, 2010 to Jan. 14, 2011 Maximum PPD stays at \$1,243 (based on prior SAWW decrease).

MINIMUM PPD: As follows or the employee's AWW, whichever is less:

DEATH BENEFITS, TOTAL & PERMANENT DISABILITY (TPD)

The employee receives 66.66% of the employee's AWW subject to:

MAXIMUM DEATH & TPD:

The statutory maximums are set out in the Maximum Weekly Rate Tables.

Up to 1/31/2006 the maximum death benefit payable is the greater of \$250,000 or 20 years of compensation at the applicable weekly rate subject to the statutory maximum.

Burial expenses are \$4,200 as of 7-1-1992.

As of 2/1/2006 the maximum death benefit payable is the greater of \$500,000 or 25 years of compensation at the applicable weekly rate subject to the statutory maximum.

Burial expenses are \$8,000 as of 2-1-2006.

MINIMUM DEATH & TPD:

The rate cannot be less than 50% of the Statewide Average Weekly Wage in effect on the date of injury.

COMPUTATION METHOD FOR MAXIMUM BENEFITS

TTD, TPD, Amputation & Eye Enucleation: Statewide AWW multiplied by 133.3333%.

Up to 1/31/2006: Maximum Death Benefit = 365 days x 20 years = 7300 days + 5 leap year days = 7305 days ÷ 7 = 1043.5714 weeks x TTD rate.

After 2/1/2006: Maximum Death Benefit = 365 days x 25 years = 9125 days + 6 leap year days = 9131 days ÷ 7 = 1304.4285 weeks x TTD rate.
